Friday, November 14, 2025, 7:30 EST Tumultuous Journey to Unity: A Detailed Vision of Humanity's Future with Maury Miloff

Drawing on an extensive Baha'i literature, Maury will outline the processes and stages through which humanity will pass in the coming decades and centuries, involving massive economic, political, technological and religious transformations, not all of them pretty, leading to a future Golden Age. Followed by questions and discussion.

About Maury:

Maury grew up in Montreal and Winnipeg. His formal education includes a BA Honours in Sociology, and a Master's in International Affairs (Integration Studies). He subsequently worked for more than thirty years in the arena of international development, managing projects and programs for UNDP, NGOs and with Canada's Department of Foreign Affairs and CIDA. During the last half of his career, he focused exclusively on building capacity for governance in developing countries, his last position being a Senior Advisor for Governance at CIDA. He lived for more than 16 years in six countries in Africa, Asia and the Middle East. Maury and his wife Helen DeMarsh have three adult children. He retired from paid work in 2013 and has since been mainly involved, among a variety of pursuits, with the Baha'i Faith and other organizations in improving community life.
